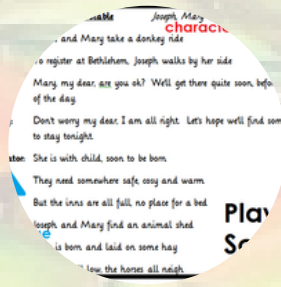
WHAT MAKES A GOOD STORY?

Dorothy, Tin Man, Lion, Scarecrow

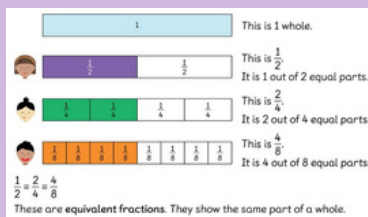
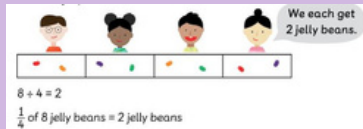
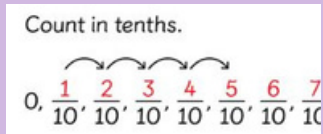


Do a review of a musical you have not seen before. (Make sure to ask adult permission)

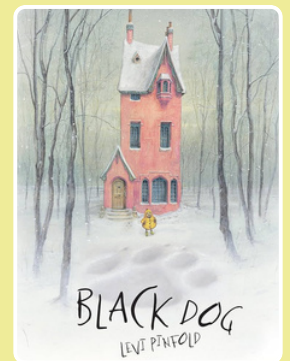

For the last three weeks of this half term we will be focussing on our performance. This will involve many new skills for us

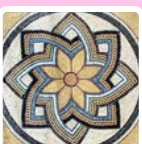
including:
